Dear ISRA Member,

The Illinois Gun Owners' Lobby Day (IGOLD) has become the number one demonstration of citizens promoting gun owners' rights in the United States – the Illinois State Rifle Association (ISRA) is its primary sponsor. Last year, approximately 7,200 gun rights supporters ascended on the State Capitol – I would like that number to reach 10,000 this year.

Please be sure to mark your calendar, and plan to attend the IGOLD rally on March 6th. The IGOLD rally will commence at the Prairie Capital Convention Center (PCCC) in Springfield, IL at 11:30am sharp; doors will open at 10:00am. We would like every person who believes in the Second Amendment to be there - please invite everyone you know! This year we will be pushing for an up and down vote on concealed carry legislation in Illinois. It is critical that we let politicians know how important our gun rights are; we will be supporting only those legislators who support our gun rights. IGOLD is the ideal time to demonstrate our commitment to the Second Amendment and the right of self-defense!

IGOLD, and the preservation of the Second Amendment rights, is an expensive undertaking that involves many people, many communications, many activities, and a lot of planning. To help offset these expenses, I have enclosed a raffle/ donation form – please enter the gun raffle or simply make a donation. Springfield Amory has, once again, donated three great guns as prizes, and the ISRA has donated a pair of BSA binoculars. For the third time, the ISRA is offering a limited-edition cloisonné pin to commemorate the 2013 IGOLD events.
