Army Qualification Test Scaled for 50-ft firing distance

Course of Fire -
50 record shots, fired in four stages


Target, Rifle, "D" (100 yd)

Reduced for 50-ft Qualification and Training (Stage 1).

STAGE 1: Standing
Position Sustained Fire
10 rounds 2 minute
time limit all 10 rounds
to be fired at the
adjacent target. Load
one magazine with 10
rounds.

AMMO Requirements
for Qualification.
65 rounds total
15 sighter & 50 for
record

SCORING: -All shots
outside the 3-ring are
scored as misses. V's are
worth 5 points and are
used to break ties only. (i.e. if more
than one person has the same score the
one with the highest number of V's wins)





ZEROING: Sighting
shots (SS) are allowed
prior to stages 1 and 4
only. Approx. 2 clicks of
elevation or windage will
move the strike of the
bullet one block on the
adjacent sighter targets.
At least three 3-shot
groups should be fired to
obtain a zero for stages
1, 2 and 3. The shot
groups for stage 1
should be centered on
the top **X**, on the middle
X for stage 2 and on the
bottom **X** for stage 3.



SIGHTER TARGETS FOR STAGES 1, 2 and 3.

NOTE: The shooter
should be able to come
down 3 clicks from the
stage 1 zero (top X) and
be zeroed for stage 2
and come down an
addi-
tional 1 click (4 clicks
total) to be zeroed for
stage 3.

Sighting targets for
stage 4 are provided on
the 400-yard target
sheet. At least two 3-
shot groups should be
fired to confirm sight
zero.
