2-Day Marksmanship Clinic July 30 & 31, 2011

Events start at 08:30. Please arrive early to allow time for set up and sign in.

The Appleseed Program is designed to take you from simply being a rifle owner to being a true Rifleman. All throughout American history, the Rifleman has been defined as a marksman capable of hitting targets from 500 yards away! This 500-yard range is traditionally known as "the rifleman's quarter-mile." A rifleman can hit just about any target he can see.

Learn the "Six steps to firing the shot." Learn correct firing positions and proper use of the sling. Hear some little-known Revolutionary War history and reaffirm your heritage. Become a more influential citizen and make America a better place.

What you should bring:

A desire to learn and improve.
A rifle (and a spare, if you have it)
Ammunition: Bring 1000 rounds – you'll use at least half, probably more.
Scope OK. GI web sling strongly recommended.
Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth.
Hat and sunscreen. Rain gear, layered clothes.
Water, lunch, snacks. Some friends!

What you can expect:

New Shooters - learn fundamentals and make quick progress.
Experienced Shooters - learn techniques to tighten your groups.
Experts – polish skills, become an RWVA Instructor in Training.
Everyone – expect to have a great time!

Active Military, Reserve, and Guard w/ ID, Peace Officers (w/ ID), Disabled (w/ ID), Re-enactors in period dress, Elected officials (w/proof) shoot for FREE!

Registration fees do not include separate range fees which vary by location.

Note: There is a host range fee of \$5.00 daily, for all except those under 18 and active members of the military.

MISC: While driving keep rifles unloaded and separate from ammo. Check www.nraila.org/statelawpdfs/MESL.pdf for other state laws that are pertinent. This event is open to adults and children 12 years of age and older. Anyone under 17 years of age must be accompanied by a parent. The water on site is NOT potable. The club will sell food and sodas, and man the grill for small fees. There is a clubhouse. As far as nearby food goes, the [44 Degrees North Pub](#) in Milbridge gets raves. There is a grocery store 3 miles away and a country store 7 miles away.

Directions

From Ellsworth, ME, go about 30 miles on US Coastal 1 N to Milbridge. In Milbridge turn right onto US 1A N for 8 miles. Continue straight as US 1A becomes US 1 N again. Go 3 miles to Epping Road, Columbia, on the left (street sign and range sign on the corner). Turn left onto Epping Road for 2.5 miles. Turn right at the range sign on the corner, then go 0.4 miles. Turn right again immediately after a small bridge. Go 0.2 miles to the club entrance on the right.
