+ IMC (downrange)

Sight adjustments (lower right, 5 rounds) + Talking Targets (downrange)  
Post Two Green Coats

Lunch/**Second Strike:** Lt. K

Line Boss PM: Tribe

NPOA Shift, Prone position (400 yard silhouettes, 10 rounds, before lunch if ahead of schedule)

Seated position (left 300 yard silhouette, 5 rounds)

NPOA Shift, Prone position (left 200 yard silhouette, right 300 yard silhouette, 10 rounds)

Standing position (right 200 yard silhouette, 5 rounds)

Standing position (left 100 yard silhouette, 5 rounds, combine with next string of fire if behind schedule)

Standing position (right 100 yard silhouette, 5 rounds)

Post QDAQT

Stage 1 standing

Transition & Mag Changes. Stage 2.

Stage 3

Stage 4

Post new QDAQT (Shoot as usual but backwards starting with stage 4) quick intros

Before Stage 1: Introduce standing mag change alternative/carbine qualification (franklinfarmer)

More AQTs if time allows, ball and dummy earlier if things are going smoothly/ahead of schedule

**Third Strike:** Roswell
