This ability is traditionally known as mastering the "Rifleman's Quarter Mile." The technology may have improved, but the skills and the passion to preserve Liberty are part of our heritage. So join us, hear some little-known Revolutionary War history and help us pass on the traditions of the American Rifleman.

What you should bring:

- ★ A desire to learn and improve.
- ★ Centerfire or .22 rimfire rifle with iron sights or scope
- ★ Peep Sights and Shooting Sling Recommended
- ★ 250 rounds of ammunition per day, per rifle
- ★ Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth.
- ★ Hat and sunscreen. Rain gear, layered clothes.
- ★ Water, lunch, snacks. Some friends!
