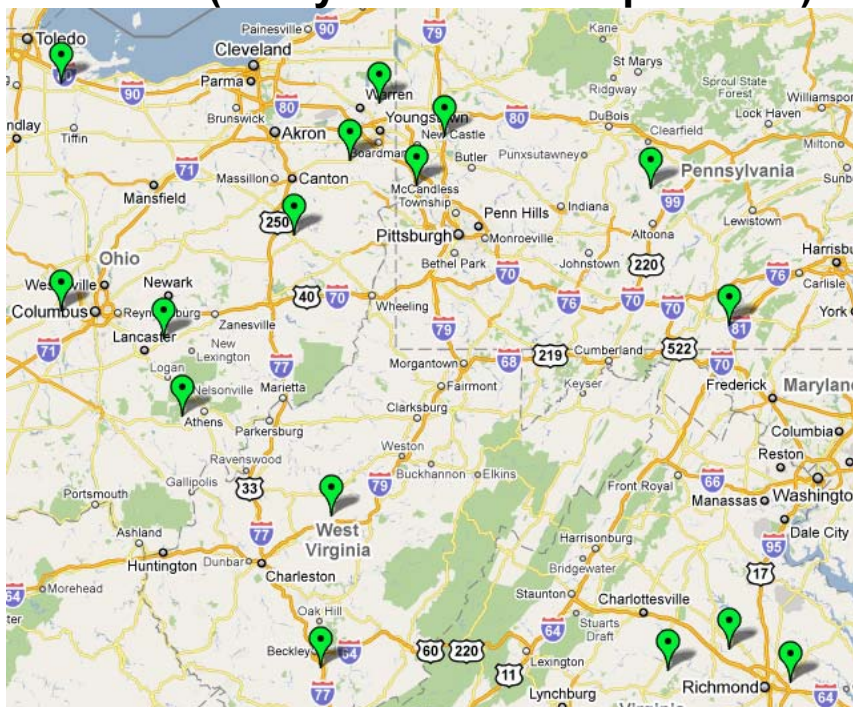


*All throughout American history, the Rifleman has been defined as a marksman capable of hitting targets from 500 yards away!
