

.50BMG RULES

When you arrive, let the Range Safety Officer know you are shooting a .50BMG.

All .50BMGs are to be assigned a bench at either end of the shooting line.

Be polite and let the shooters next you know when you are about to fire.

- **Targets**

You can set up a target frame from 25yds to 300yds.

You may shoot directly into the dirt back berms .

You CANNOT shoot at ANY Steel targets.

You CANNOT shoot at ANY rocks, boulders or anywhere into the mountain.

- **Ammunition NOT PERMITTED on the range.**

Red Tip – Tracer “M1” (surplus)

Orange Tip – Tracer “M10” (surplus)

Light Blue Tip – incendiary “M1” (surplus)

Silver Tip - Armor-Piercing-Incendiary “M8” (surplus)

Any type of tracer or incendiary ammunition
