Rifleman Boot Camp: July 11-18, 2010

Shoot starts at 08:30. Please arrive early to allow time for set up and sign in.

The Appleseed Program is designed to take you from simply being a rifle owner to being a true Rifleman. All throughout American history, the Rifleman has been defined as a marksman capable of hitting targets from 500 yards away! This 500-yard range is traditionally known as "the rifleman's quarter-mile." A rifleman can hit just about any target he can see.

Rifleman Boot Camp, or RBC, is an intensive, in-depth course designed to maximize your skills, while giving you personalized instruction. Following the first six days of RBC, we will have a conventional, 2-day Appleseed; still chock-full of information, but it goes a bit faster.

Can't decide? Come to the RBC and participate in the regular Appleseed, and everyone will be absolutely amazed at your shooting skills!

What you should bring:

A desire to learn and improve.
A rifle (and a spare, if you have it)
Ammunition: At least 250 rounds per day.
Scope OK. GI web sling strongly recommended.
Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth.
Hat, bug repellent and sunscreen. Rain gear,
layered clothes. Water, lunch, snacks. Some
friends!

What you can expect:

New Shooters - learn fundamentals and make quick progress.
Experienced Shooters - learn techniques to tighten your groups.
Experts – polish skills, become an RWVA Instructor in Training.
Everyone – expect to have a great time!

Shooters under 21, active military (including reserves and guard), and women shoot for FREE!

Range fee **includes** dormitory with bunks/mattresses, restrooms, showers, swimming pool, meeting hall/chow hall/kitchen....you will need to bring bed linens or sleeping bags and food.
