What is Appleseed?

We are an all-volunteer, non-profit 501.c.3 organization that teaches rifle marksmanship clinics nationwide.

We teach standing, sitting, and prone positions, we teach how to use a sling to steady your position, we teach the six steps of taking the shot, we teach Natural Point of Aim, we teach, inches to minutes of angle to clicks conversion so that you can adjust the sights on your specific rifle and we couple this with American Revolutionary War History, in particular, the events of April 19th 1775.

Do you know what this date represents? This was the date of the battles of Lexington and Concord and the start of the Revolutionary War. We teach the heritage of what rifle marksmanship means to the beginnings of our country. We like to say we take American rifle owners and turn them into American Riflemen, we'll show you the difference and we'll teach you why that's important.

Most of the shooting is done at 25 meters. You can use your centerfire rifle if you like (and if full distance is available, you may get the chance to shoot at full distance later in the weekend). But for the 25 meter shooting, a .22 rifle can teach you just as much, for a lot less expense in ammo.
