All shoots start promptly at 08:30, unless otherwise specified.

The Appleseed Program is designed to take you from simply being a rifle owner to being a true Rifleman. All throughout American history, the Rifleman has been defined as a marksman capable of hitting targets from 500 yards away! This 500-yard range is traditionally known as "the rifleman's quarter-mile;" a rifleman can hit just about any target he can see.

Learn the "Six steps to firing the shot." Learn correct firing positions and proper use of the sling.  
Hear some little-known Revolutionary War history and reaffirm your heritage.  
Become a more influential citizen and make America a better place.

#### What you should bring:

A desire to learn and improve.  
Centerfire or .22 rimfire rifle, or both.  
Scope OK. Sling strongly recommended.  
250 rounds of ammunition per day, per rifle.  
Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth.  
Hat and sunscreen. Rain gear, layered clothes.  
Water, lunch, snacks. Some friends!

*What is a Rifleman Boot Camp?* A Rifleman Boot Camp, or RBC, is an intensive, in-depth course designed to maximize your skills, while giving you personalized instruction. Following the first 6 days of the RBC, we will have a conventional 2 day Appleseed; still chock-full of information, but it goes a bit faster. Can't decide? Come to the RBC and participate in the regular Appleseed – no extra charge! Everyone will be absolutely amazed at your shooting skills.

#### What you can expect:

New Shooters - learn the fundamentals and make quick progress.  
Experienced Shooters - learn techniques to tighten your groups.  
Expert Shooters – polish your shooting AND teaching skills.  
Everyone – expect to have a great time

Walk-on fees are \$80.00 for both days, or \$50.00 for one day.

Pre-register, be sure of a place, and save! \$70.00 for both days, or \$45.00 for one day.

#### Directions

From Charleston, WV: Take I-79 North to Exit 40 (Big Otter); turn left at stop (Rt.16N); continue about 3.75 miles and look for green Calhoun County sign on right; turn right at first white church (Unity Gospel Tabernacle); continue on gravel/dirt road about 0.8 mile to farm.

From Morgantown, WV: Take I-79 South to Exit 40 (Big Otter); turn right at stop (Rt.16N); continue about 3.75 miles and look for green Calhoun County sign on right; turn right at first white church (Unity Gospel Tabernacle); continue on gravel/dirt road about 0.8 mile to farm.

Camping available: On site - primitive camping next to a pond. Firewood and fire pits available during cooler weather.  
Potable water available and limited electricity.
