

# STOP SB249!

## ATTENTION CALGUNNERS!

We are facing the largest gun confiscation scheme ever – SB249. We need everyone to **reach out to all our senators and assembly members and voice opposition to SB249** by phone, by e-mail, by letter, twitter, Facebook, fax and, if you live in the Sacramento area, personal visit.

## What is SB249?

Right now there are hundreds of thousands of rifles that are 100% legal to buy and own in California, if SB 249 becomes law it will make these rifles illegal and their owners will become criminals overnight.

You will be told to surrender to the State those rifles that you bought and paid for legally and the State is under no obligation to and will not reimburse you for them.

You will simply be left with the choice to either give up the rifles you paid hundreds if not thousands of dollars for to be destroyed by the State or become a criminal.

All of this because SB 249 seeks to redefine "detachable magazine" as any ammunition feeding device that can be removed from the firearm without disassembly of the rifle.

This means that if your rifle has a magazine that can be detached from your rifle by pressing a button *either with the finger or by use of a tool or a bullet* you will become a criminal automatically and subject to fines, jail time and confiscation of your legally purchased property.

## How to Help:

**When you contact everyone please remember the following:**

1. Be Courteous – Let's make allies, not enemies.
2. Be Respectful – Just because you disagree, don't be rude.
3. Be Clear – Before contact, make a short list of talking points.
4. Be Relatable – Drop jargon (OLL, BB, C&R) and use understandable language.
5. Be Succinct – Keep it short and sweet!
6. Be Persistent – Don't let them forget who you are! Call them back the next week and the week after and so on!
7. Be Patient – Not everyone comes around first, second, or third try.

We need to make sure our voices are heard, not just by our fellow Second Amendment rights activists, but by our opposition. We ask that you contact Senator Yee and the Appropriations Committee at least once and preferably more often than that. Remember that when you contact Senator Yee, Committee members, or any other public official you represent all of us. Use your phone, your e-mail, Twitter, Facebook, fax, and your mail box as often as you can!
