Ok folks **I'm hyped about Project Appleseed!** You just have to visit their site (<http://appleseedinfo.org/>), learn all about this project and then attend a few events (2days), a Rifleman Boot Camp (1 wk) or become an instructor in your area. Attend and learn about our American heritage while you improve your marksmanship. **Above all spread the word about Project Appleseed.**



Through **Project Appleseed**, the **Revolutionary War Veterans Association** is committed to teaching two things: rifle marksmanship and our early American heritage. They do this for one simple reason, the skill and knowledge of what our founding fathers left to us is eroding in modern America and without deliberate action, they will be lost to ignorance and apathy.



I'll admit I was a bit concerned when one of the shooters said **"Be prepared to be humbled"**. He apparently has gotten shooting awards yet was on his second try for his Rifleman Badge with Appleseed!!!! Boy was he was oohh sooo right ;-}



Since I was using a rifle (S&W M&P 15/.22) that I had never fired before in my life, I figured I was in for a long weekend. Yet the weekend flew by much too quickly.



Despite my arthritic hands and raw elbows I learned tons and even managed to hit that Red Coat "Murphy" once ;}



**This is real instructor led, personalized instruction** that will use up from 500-1000 rounds of ammo for a two day shoot. The teaching method used is the traditional 'Rifleman's Quarter mile', which is an uniquely American Rifleman skill, that has been part of this nation from the very first days.



You are taught fundamental rifle marksmanship skills that are to allow a Rifleman to be accurate out to 500 yards (conducted at 25 meters, at reduced size targets to simulate 100 to 500 yards and Standard Army Qualification Targets (AQT)) with iron sights (you can use a scope, however if you learn with iron sights a scope is easy), standard rifle and surplus ammo.



**These are great events, good for the whole family** and something I think every rifle owner and their household should attend – novice or sharpshooter, young or old, in just about any physical condition (Ya gotta be able to see to shoot).

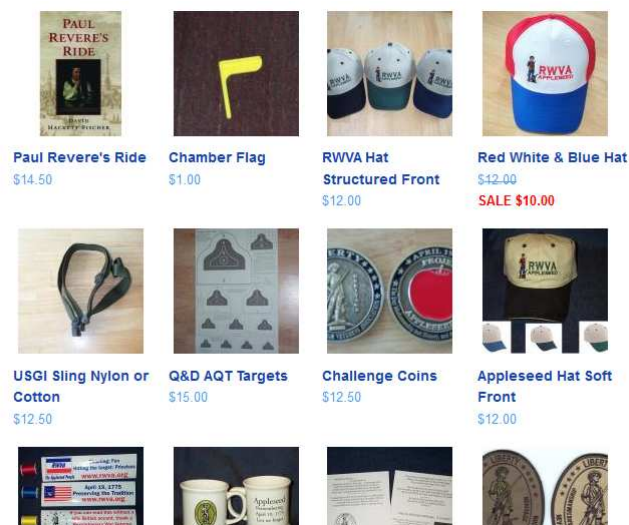

## Pricing for 2 Day Events

- FREE - Active Military, Reserve, National Guard, and Peace Officers.
- \$70 - For two full days of instruction\*
- \$45 - Single day\*
- \$10 - Women - A substantial discount over the normal \$70 pre-reg fee!
- \$5 - Youths under 21.
- Walk-on price is \$80/weekend, \$50/single day, if space is available on the firing line.
- A small additional range fee may be required for all shooters at some locations. See specific location information for details and directions.

\*Pre-registration is encouraged for events, as Appleseed has to staff events so there is a good student to instructor ratio.

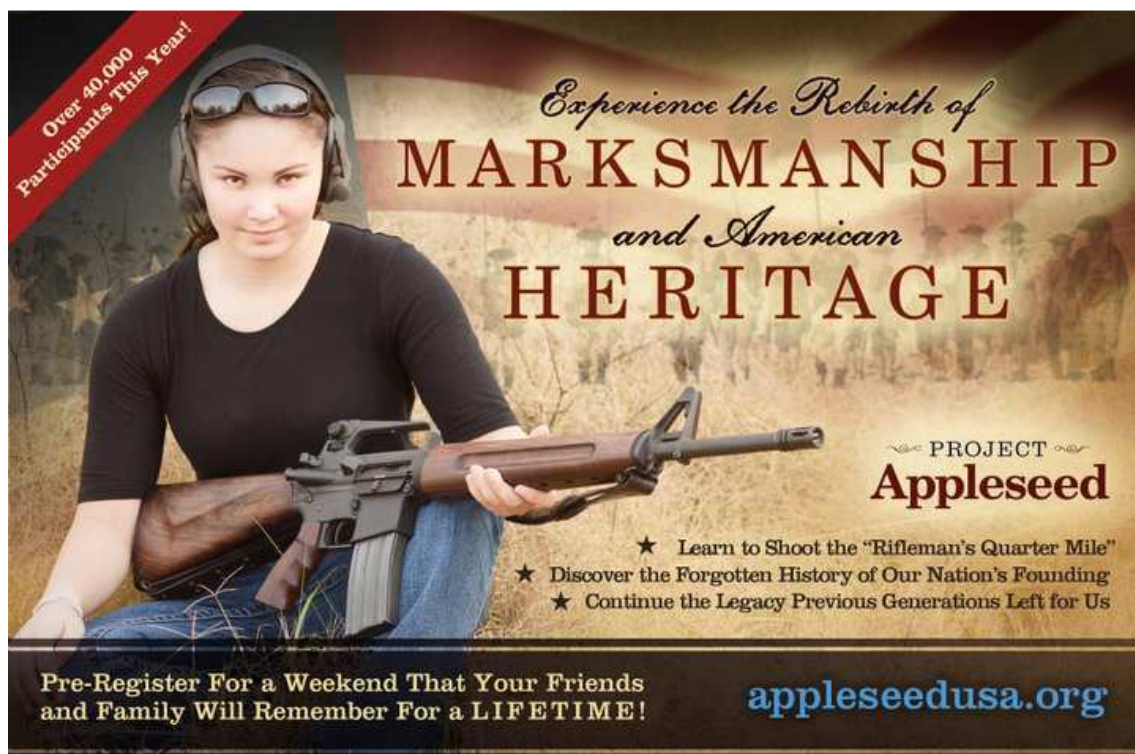
