Preregistration Fees (per person): \$45 for one day or \$70 for both days. Women: \$5 for one day or \$10 for both days. Under 21: \$2.50 for one day or \$5 for both days. Walk on fees are higher. Active Military, Reserve, and Guard w/ ID, Law Enforcement Officers (w/ ID), Disabled (w/ ID), Re-enactors in period dress, Elected officials (w/proof) shoot for free!

Appleseed preregistration does not include separate range fees which vary by location. There is no range fee for Ethan Allen Firing Range events. However, there may be a \$5 fee for KD targets.

Misc.: This is one of the few ranges RWVA uses that has 600 yard capability. We will be shooting a 400 yard AQT on Sunday, so bring a center fire rifle and 200 rounds of ammo for it. It's a very beautiful range. Shooting here is a treat not be missed. It's not many places in the program that allow a Full Distance AQT. Our Instructors are very knowledgeable in the area of Full Distance shooting. Some of them may very well be on the line shooting with you.
