

# Appleseed Shoot

Would you like to be able to make hits out to 500 yards with YOUR rifle?

Learn the "Six steps to firing the shot." Learn correct firing positions and proper sling use. Hear some little-known Revolutionary War history and reaffirm your heritage. Become a more influential citizen and make America a better place by using "The Seventh Step."

#### What you should bring:

A desire to learn and improve. Centerfire or .22 rimfire rifle, or both. Scope OK. Sling strongly recommended. 250 rounds of ammunition per day, per rifle. Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth. Hat and sunscreen. Rain gear, layered clothes. Water, lunch, snacks. Some friends!

#### What you can expect:

New shooters - learn the fundamentals and make quick progress.

Experienced shooters - learn techniques to tighten your groups.

Expert shooters – polish your shooting AND teaching skills.

Everyone – expect to have a great time!

How can this clinic be both 8 and 2 days? Because Directions: the 8-day clinic, which we call Rifleman Boot Camp, or RBC, is an intensive, in-depth, course designed to maximize your skills, while giving you personalized instruction. Following the RBC, we will have a conventional, 2-day Appleseed; still chock-full of information, but it goes a bit faster. Can't decide? Come to the RBC and then stay for the Appleseed. Everyone will be absolutely amazed at your shooting skills.

(If you are attending the RBC, call for special camping and meal info.)

From I-70 Take US 54 west to Osage Beach. Turn East on State Hwy. 42, 10 miles to Brumley. Turn NORTH on Rt. 'C'. ( caution, here. Rt 'C' goes north AND south from 42) Approx. 3 miles on Rt. 'C' watch for gravel road on right marked with RWVA signs, and follow signs to range

From I-44 Take St. Hwy 5 exit at Lebanon, and take Hwy 5 to Camdenton. Take US 54 EAST to Osage Beach, turn East on St. Hwy. 42, 10 miles to Brumley and follow above directions to range.

**Camping Available!** Camping is available on site, with water available and porta- toilets. This is FREE! We will provide bonfires each evening and possibly wood for individual campfires, depending on attendance. (No electricity.)
