 \star Learn the essentials of shooting a rifle from multiple positions (standing, kneeling, sitting, prone), 6 steps of firing the shot, breathing and trigger control, natural point of aim, how to quickly zero any rifle, range estimation, trajectory and a whole lot more!

Project Appleseed[™] is part of a nationwide, non-profit, educational organization* that teaches rifle marksmanship skills and history of our Nation's founding. This two-day event will include instruction on gun safety and proper marksmanship techniques, using modern rifles. Students will also have the opportunity to earn the coveted Rifleman patch by shooting a qualifying score on the Appleseed Qualification Test (AQT).

In addition to expert marksmanship instruction, students will hear historical storytellers passionately share the Three Strikes of the Match, a series of three pivotal events that ignited the Revolutionary War. Project Appleseed[™] events are suitable for both new and experienced shooters. Families are welcome.

What you should bring:

- \star A desire to learn and improve.
- ★ A rifle, sighted in at 25 meters, if possible
- ★ Shooting Sling Recommended - inexpensive GI type web slings work best
- \star 250 rounds of ammunition per day
- \star Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth.
- ★ Hat and sunscreen. Rain gear, layered clothes.
- ★ Water, lunch, snacks. Some friends!


Appleseed Fees, which include Saturday & Sunday
