<u>Project Appleseed</u> is a nationwide program that <u>teaches participants the traditional rifle</u> <u>marksmanship skills</u> that have been passed down from generation to generation <u>and also</u> <u>reconnects today's Americans with the people and events of colonial America</u>. Participants are taught fundamental rifle marksmanship skills that allow a Rifleman to be accurate out to 500 yards using a standard rifle with iron sights and surplus ammunition. This ability is traditionally known as mastering the "Rifleman's Quarter Mile" and is an American skill that has been part of this nation from its very first days.
